

## News from Dunn Commodities

We are delighted to announce the launch of the **Organic Expeller Company** – the only establishment to produce organic expeller soya meal and oil in the UK. A subsidiary of Dunn Commodities, the Company will supply the organic animal feed market. By processing in the UK, we remove the risk of buying products manufactured overseas and ensure quality throughout the manufacturing process. The process involves removing the soya hulls by which we can offer the first **organic High Protein (HiPro) soya** with a minimum crude protein level of 48%, compared to the standard 44% material currently available.

Obviously, soya beans must be imported into the UK. Our quality assurance process for imports is studded with checks at every point, and our comprehensive membership of quality assurance schemes (FEMAS and Soil Association) verifies our QA process. Every shipment of organic soya beans will be loaded under the supervision of *Eurofins* and GM tests will be carried out on every shipment. Containers arriving at the Organic Expeller Company will be further verified using GM test strips before processing. We therefore believe that organic and non-GM status will be guaranteed.

With effective contacts and efficient supply chains, Dunn Commodities can source products internationally, including **organic sunflower meal, organic rape meal** and a **pelleted blend containing 85% organic wheat and 15% organic expeller soya meal**. With our strategically positioned stores, we are able to supply and deliver such feed materials direct to farm in loads ranging from one tonne to 29 tonnes. From mid October, we will have **organic molasses** available in bulk. We already have a substantial tonnage of molasses in 1 tonne recyclable containers in store in Grangemouth for our Scottish clients.

Dunn Commodities is continuing to build new developments in the organic feed range. This entails substantial investment to meet our customers' needs for a quality product. We are determined to offer products which ensure compliance to the organic standard and current feed legislation as well as meeting the nutritional requirements of organic livestock in the UK.
